- We will once again do the cheeseburger fundraiser in Wimberley, this time at the VFW which gives us an indoor facility to work with and a drive-up window for those picking up a meal. This will be on a Wednesday in early May at a date still to be set.

- Hold a bingo night at the Wimberley VFW during the summer, possibly including dinner. We have all materials necessary already with the exception of the actual bingo cards which we will need to purchase.

- Then in the fall, we are looking into either a Fun Run or a golf tournament. We need to secure locations for either of these events to be able to move ahead. Jack spoke with Kissing Tree Golf Club this morning and received information on how the golf tournament could be held there. Jack also contacted Plum Creek Golf Course, but they were not very receptive to hold a tournament.

**Trophy Case Update** - Cathy stated that David is working on the case with expected delivery still on target for March or early April
