January 12, 2016 -TSCRA Welcomes New Special Ranger to Austin Area Fort Worth, Texas – Former Travis County Sheriff’s Office Detective Kenny Murchison, of Lockhart, Texas, has joined the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association (TSCRA) as a Special Ranger for District 20, which includes Bastrop, Burnet, Caldwell, Fayette, Hays, Lee, Travis, Washington and Williamson counties. Murchison replaced former TSCRA Special Ranger Doug Hutchison who recently retired.
